This is an **Archery NZ registered tournament**. **Non Archery NZ** members can shoot in an “**Open**” class but are not eligible for Archery NZ records.

World Archery 3D is a one (1) arrow round. For those considering qualification for the 2017 World Archery World 3D Championships in France, we would recommend you enter this tournament & be an Archery NZ member.

Dress Code: As this is a field event there is no requirement to wear club uniforms (you can if you wish). Appropriate Sports clothing with non-offensive logos or writing is suitable, NO CAMO is allowed as per World Archery rules. Closed in shoes are a requirement, however boots are recommended. Archers initials on each arrow please.

Please bring water to carry during the shoot. TVDS will be putting on some food for lunch which will be available for purchase, so bring some money too.

For compound archers shooting unmarked rounds the follow equipment is not permitted:

- Multiple sight pins and peep eliminator devices.
- No part of the sight may be modified for the purpose of providing means for range finding.
- Tracer nocks (electrically/electronically lighted nocks).
- String silencers are allowed provided they are located no closer than 30cm from the nocking point.
- Maximum bow poundage 60lbs.

For athletes of all divisions shooting unmarked rounds the following equipment is not permitted:

- Any electronic or electrical device that can be attached to the athlete's equipment.
- Any electronic communication device (including mobile phones), headsets or noise reduction devices in front of the waiting line on the practice field and at any time on the course.
- On unmarked rounds any type of range finders or any other means of estimating distances or angles not covered by the current rules regarding athlete's equipment.
- Any part of an athlete's equipment that has been added or modified to serve the purpose of estimating distances or angles, nor may any regular piece of equipment be used explicitly for that purpose.
- Any written memoranda or electronic storage device that may be used for calculating angles, and distances apart from notes of the athlete's normal sight marks, the recording of the present personal scores or any part of the World Archery Rules
